Year 6 WW2 Evacuee Day













Parking



Play your part in keeping the area outside our school safe

During last year several vehicles received a fixed penalty charge for parking or stopping outside our school and other local schools. Park Legal will be making regular appearances with foot patrols and camera cars this academic year to help ensure our community stays safer for all travelling to and from school.

The Highway code states:

Rule 238

You **MUST NOT** wait or park on yellow lines during the times of operation shown on nearby time plates (or zone entry signs if in a Controlled Parking Zone)

You **MUST NOT** wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings when upright signs indicate a prohibition of stopping.

Please ensure your child has breakfast at home each day. Breakfast is the most important meal of the day. Breakfast consumption in children has been found to:

- Improve cognitive function, particularly memory, attention, and executive function
- Improve academic performance
- Increase on-task behaviour in the class

Health and Safety

The children **should not** be wearing jewellery to school, including bracelets and necklaces. Stud earrings are permitted, no dangly or hooped earrings as these could get caught when the children are running around in the playground or during PE lessons. Earrings need to be removed or taped and long hair tied back for PE, tape is to be brought in from home.




